WHS School Dance Policy

For any student found under the influence and/or in possession of drugs and/or alcohol, there will be **only one strike afforded, and that student will not be allowed to attend any of the remaining dances during that school year (including proms).**

- Breathalyzer(s) will be used on students at random as well as upon reasonable suspicion of intoxication. All bags are also subject to search with owner in attendance.
- Parents will be called and asked to bring their son/daughter home immediately.
- The Westerly Police Department will also be notified of any individual(s) in possession of alcohol or drugs and/or paraphernalia.

For inappropriate dancing or touching,

- The individual(s) will first be given a warning documented by the removal of the wristband received at the door.
- **If this occurs again at that same dance, the individual(s) will be dismissed, given their first strike, and banned from the next dance in that school year (including proms).**
- If in the same school year this individual(s) is dismissed from another dance for any reason, **they will receive their second strike and will be banned from the remainder of the dances (including proms) during that school year.**
- **Anyone who receives two strikes in one school year will have a one strike limit for the following school year** (if applicable).

WHS administration will meet with the parents of any student removed from a dance.

Students must be present for **100% of the school day** (or the Friday of a weekend function) in order to enter the dance. No exceptions.

Students must dress tastefully. If at any time during the dance, a student's attire is found to be inappropriate they will be asked to leave. (*Attire may become inappropriate i.e. dresses riding up, pants falling down etc...*)

Students will not be able to purchase tickets for a dance until this form has been signed by both the student and his or her parent/guardian.

This form will be kept on file for your time here at WHS. Unless there is a change to the policy you will not be asked to fill out another one.

Any student from outside WHS must sign this form along with the typical guest registration paperwork.

We as a school are not trying to make dances a strictly regimented event. Dances are supposed to be an event where students can have fun and enjoy themselves, but it is essential to understand that drugs, alcohol, and inappropriate behavior are not necessary to make such a fun night possible. This is NOT AN ELIMINATION OF OUR DANCE STYLE. We are all aware that our style of dancing can be achieved and performed without being inappropriate!
